US Drug Check, LLC

Purpose

US Drug Check, LLC offers DOT and workplace drug and alcohol testing programs in all states and cities. Services are provided for employers that need to be in compliance with DOT regulations and/or drug-free workplace programs.

Who This Program Supports

- Employers with DOT-regulated roles
- Safety managers and Designated Employer Representatives (DERs)
- HR and operations teams managing policy-based workplace programs
- Owner-operators and small fleets that need consortium/C/TPA support

How Service Delivery Works

1) Program Setup and Scope Alignment

- Confirm employer structure, DER contacts, and program scope
- Align DOT and/or workplace requirements
- Establish random cadence (quarterly or monthly)
- Prepare collection site coordination workflow

2) Random Administration and Collection Coordination

- Randoms are processed quarterly or monthly according to company protocol
- Participant list is verified before each pull
- Analysis reports are supplied with each selection so the DER can monitor percentages
- Notification letters and collection site instruction sheets are supplied for each cycle

3) Post-Accident and Reasonable-Suspicion Support

- Assistance is provided 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Alternate collection sites are coordinated when needed
- Every effort is made to coordinate drug and alcohol testing within DOT required post-accident timeframes

4) Positive Result Coordination

- Positive results are assigned to a program administrator
- Support is provided for employer/DER communication steps, documentation flow, SAP coordination, return-to-duty, and follow-up scheduling

5) Reporting and Recordkeeping

- Results are reported the same day after MRO verification, generally within 24 hours of collection
- Next day reporting workflows are also part of standard delivery

- Electronic reporting occurs in real time
- Records are organized for filing, typically including MRO report, CCF, and affidavits when required

Affidavits of Correction

When errors occur, affidavits are supplied to the Lab or MRO to help ensure each drug screen is performed with 100% accuracy.

Clearinghouse Support Scope

US Drug Check provides FMCSA Clearinghouse compliance support and documentation coordination. Regulatory authority and enforcement remain with the appropriate agencies.

- Live administrator access by phone and email
- Clear random selection and percentage-tracking outputs
- Coordinated collection network support across states and cities
- Reporting after MRO verification with consistent communication
- Organized documentation for internal files and audit readiness
